- *Amid the chaos of 2020, discuss two situations that brought you joy and peace.*
- *In the last year, many aspects of our daily life have been forever altered as a result of a global pandemic and racial injustice. How have you been able to maintain courage and adjust to all the many changes that have occurred in the course of a year? What have you learned because of your faith?*

**Be sure to also include a biographical sketch describing your career goals and aspirations.*

You are required to have:

Three (3) reference letters:

- One (1) academic reference from a teacher who will document your academic abilities and achievements.
- One (1) from a Guidance Counselor.
- One (1) from an adult community leader who will document your community involvement, character, and leadership skills.

Applications without essays and/or reference letters will not be considered.

Submit an **Official Transcript** documents from high or trade school.

Submit a copy of the acceptance letter to college or trade school.

Submit a head-shot photo
